
This refers to your response dated October 22, 1987 and your check for \$1,000 in payment for the civil penalty proposed by NRC in the Order Modifying License and Notice of Violation and Proposed Imposition of Civil Penalty issued September 23, 1987.

We have reviewed your audit program and find it acceptable except that it does not include License No. 42-01068-07 which was listed in the Order. Accordingly, please submit a revised audit program to include License No. 42-01068-07. We would appreciate receiving your response within 30 days of the date of this letter.

We have reviewed your response to Violation A in the Notice of Violation, and agree that possession of the material was not unauthorized. Therefore, Violation A has been changed as follows:

Pursuant to 10 CFR 30.3, no person shall possess or use byproduct material except as authorized by specific or general licenses issued pursuant to 10 CFR Chapter I.

Contrary, to the above, during the period of April 11, 1985 to December 19, 1985, Halliburton Company, without authorization from the NRC cut spent fuel racks into pieces.
