Subject: ORDER MODIFYING LICENSEE AND NOTICE OF VIOLATION
AND PROPOSED IMPOSITION OF CIVIL PENALTY - \$1,000

This is to inform the Commission that an Order Modifying License and Notice of Violation and Proposed Imposition of Civil Penalty in the amount of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) will be issued on or about September 23, 1987 to Halliburton Company. These actions are based on several violations including (1) unauthorized use of byproduct material, (2) failure to calibrate survey instruments, (3) failure to properly instruct individuals involved in operations using licensed materials, (4) failure to maintain materials accountability records, (5) failure to maintain records of survey results, and (6) failure to post documents and notices. These violations collectively demonstrate a breakdown in management oversight and control of the licensee's radiation protection program. They also demonstrate the need to implement a thorough internal auditing program with management review. Accordingly, an Order Modifying Licenses is being issued which requires that the licensee implement a plan for performing internal audits and corporate management notification of audit results.

It should be noted that the licensee has not been specifically informed of the enforcement action. The schedule of issuance and notification is:

The licensee has thirty days from the date of the Notice in which to respond. Following NRC evaluation of the response, the civil penalty may be remitted, mitigated, or imposed by Order.
