4/19/2012 (08:11) I left a message on Mr. Curry's voice-mail for him to get back in touch with me about an initial inspection of the licensee's program. (08:35) Mr. Curry returned my call and informed me that, due to Congress not appropriating funds for the program, no licensed activities have been performed as of this date. I stated that the NRC required that an on-site inspection be performed within one year of issuance of a license. The one-year anniversary of the license is May 31, 2012. I provided Mr. Curry with the information that I would need to get on base and that the inspection would occur on May 21, 2012. Mr. Curry had questions about what information was necessary to put another authorized user on the license and a possible change in Radiation Safety Officer. I provided the requested information and stated that if he had any further questions, I could answer him at the time of the inspection.
