Dear Mr. Dricks,

Pursuant to the federal Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. Section 552, I request access to and copies of all summaries and minutes of meetings between the NRC and Southern California Edison regarding its steamgenerator replacements at San Onofre Nuclear Power Plant one year ago. In addition, I request access to and copies of any documents submitted by Southern California Edison regarding steam generator replacement between 2003 and 2012.

I would prefer to receive the information in electronic format. I understand there might be a fee involved with the processing of this request. As a representative of the news media, I understand I am only required to pay for the direct cost of duplication after the first 100 pages.

If my request is denied in whole or part, I ask that you justify all deletions by reference to specific exemptions of the act. I will also expect you to release all segregable portions of otherwise exempt material. I, of course, reserve the right to appeal your decision to withhold any information or to deny a waiver of fees.

As I am making this request as a journalist, and this information is of timely value, I would appreciate your communicating with me by telephone, rather than by mail, if you have questions regarding this request.

I look forward to your reply within 20 business days, as the statute requires. Thank you for your assistance.
