Dear Ms. McDonald:

The Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1990, as amended, requires that the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC or the Commission) recover through fees 90 percent of its fiscal year (FY) 2012 budget authority, not including amounts appropriated for Waste Incidental to Reprocessing and generic homeland security activities. The President signed the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2012 on December 23, 2011, giving the NRC a total appropriation of \$1,038.1 million for FY 2012. In order to comply with the law, the Commission is amending its fee regulations. The FY 2012 Final Fee rule is based on the FY 2012 appropriation language which authorizes the NRC to collect the required fees by September 30, 2012. Based on the FY 2012 budget submitted to the Congress, the final rule allows the NRC to recover approximately \$909.5 million in FY 2012.

Enclosed is a copy of the final rule which is being transmitted to the *Federal Register* for publication. The rule will become effective 60 days after publication.
