Dear Mr. Lanier,

This is in regards to Mr. Mixon's letter dated April 13, 2012 concerning License Condition 17 of your NRC License No. 07-28386-01. In order for us to continue our review, we will need additional information:

1. In the last sentence of the first paragraph, you refer to 10 CFR 30.17. There is no regulation by this citation. Should this be 10 CFR 30.70?
2. Attached to your letter you included your material transfer report for 2010. Have you submitted your transfer report for 2011?
3. Did you provide this 2010 report to our headquarters office in accordance with 10 CFR 32.12(a)? Same for 2011?
4. All of the recipient information contained in your 2010 material transfer report appear to be Agreement State licensees. Did you provide this information to the Agreement States too?
5. When working in these locations, please confirm that you used your NRC license to obtain reciprocity with the Agreement State(s)?
6. Based on a review of your 2008, 2009 and 2010 material transfer reports, it appears that you worked in NRC jurisdiction once at St. Croix in 2008. Please review 10 CFR 30.36(d) – 24 month decommissioning timeliness rule and provide a response.

We will continue our review upon receipt of this information. Please reply to my attention at the Region I Office and refer to Mail Control No. 577450. If you have any technical questions regarding this deficiency letter, please call me at (610) 337-5251.

If we do not receive a reply from you within 30 calendar days from the date of this letter, we will assume that you do not wish to pursue your application.
