D. Plan Organization

1. The County EOP includes Volume 1, the Basic Plan, which is divided into ten supporting sections; and Volume 2, Support Annexes, which is divided into seven supporting chapters.
2. The Basic Plan provides a relatively broad conceptual framework and describes the approach to a comprehensive emergency management system emphasizing an "all-hazards" approach to emergency preparedness. It relates information relevant to the whole plan and all of its sections.
3. The ten sections of the Basic Plan are organized according to PEMA standards and describe general functions. These include:
 - a. Purpose;
 - b. Policies;
 - c. Situation and Assumptions;
 - d. Concept of Operations;
 - e. Organization and Assignment of Responsibilities;
 - f. Administration and Logistics;
 - g. Authorities and References;
 - h. Acronyms and Definitions;
 - i. Training and Exercises; and
 - j. Plan Development, Maintenance and Distribution.
4. The Emergency Operations Plan Annexes address emergency operations and vital information. The Annexes contain the operational tools for an all-hazards approach to emergency management. There are six Emergency Operations Plan Annexes, including:
 - a. Emergency Support Function Annex;
 - b. Standard Operating Procedures Annex;
 - c. Incident Specific Annex;
 - d. Emergency Response Notification and Resource Manual;
 - e. Terrorism Incident Annex; and
 - f. Support Annex.

E. Authorities and References

1. Ultimate responsibility for the protection of life and property and the preservation of public health, safety, and welfare lies with local governments in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. The authority for local governments to respond to situations, declare emergencies, respond to situations, and take actions necessary to safeguard the life and property of its citizens is set forth in Pennsylvania Emergency Management Services Code, (35 Pa. C.S.), Section 7101 et seq., as amended.

STATEMENT OF AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
THE NORTHUMBERLAND COUNTY EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY
AND
THE SUNBURY CHAPTER OF THE AMERICAN RED CROSS

1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this Statement of Agreement is to provide for cooperation and coordination between Northumberland County Emergency Management Agency and the Sunbury Chapter of the American Red Cross in carrying out their assigned responsibilities in the event of natural or man-made disasters or enemy attack.

2. DEFINITION OF DISASTER

A disaster is an occurrence such as hurricane, tornado, storm, nuclear power plant accident, flood, high water, wind-driven water, tidal wave, earthquake, drought, blizzard, pestilence, famine, fire explosion, volcanic eruption, building collapse, transportation wreck, enemy attack, or other situation that causes human suffering or creates human needs that the victims cannot alleviate without assistance.

3. AUTHORITY

- A. The Statement of Agreement between the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and the American National Red Cross finalized on July 21, 1987. The agreement states that there are to be cooperative arrangements for planning preparedness and disaster operations between the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency and the American Red Cross. It encourages the County Emergency Management Agency and the local American Red Cross Chapters to establish similar arrangements.
- B. The Sunbury Chapter of the American Red Cross The American Red Cross (ARC) through its Sunbury Chapter is an instrumentality of the United States Government, with a Congressional Charter, codified at 36 U.S.C., Section 1 et. seq., and the Disaster Relief Act of 1974 (P.L. 93-288).

- C. County of Northumberland
The Northumberland County Emergency Management Agency (County EMA) was established in accordance with the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Services Code (35 Pa. C.S.). The County Emergency Management Agency has been designated as the Agency responsible for management of county emergency operations.

4. RESPONSIBILITIES - County Emergency Management Agency

- A. Northumberland County EMA will devote its primary efforts to: the county wide dissemination of warnings, human rescue, emergency medical care, evacuation and other property protection measures. The Northumberland County EMA will, as necessary and practical, provide initial emergency care and other vital assistance immediately required by people in need.
- B. The Northumberland County EMA Coordinator will represent the County as a full member of the Sunbury ARC Chapter's disaster committee.
- C. Northumberland County EMA will act as the County's coordinating agency for mass care activities as follows:
1. Selection of and planning for the utilization of mass care centers.
 2. Planning and coordination with the ARC to include obtaining written agreements with the ARC and owners/directors or School Boards of facilities to be used as mass care centers.
 3. Notifying the ARC of the occurrence of an incident and determining the time, number and type of facilities to be opened based upon the size of the disaster. Advising the ARC when its support is no longer required.
 4. Assist the ARC in recruiting and training volunteers to fulfill mass care functions throughout the county. The County EMA will keep the ARC informed regarding available training opportunities and, in cases where both parties offer similar training, attempt to consolidate the training into one program.
 5. Reporting unmet needs to the appropriate PEMA Area Office.

5. RESPONSIBILITIES - The Sunbury Chapter of the American Red Cross
- A. The ARC will respond to those disasters as defined in paragraph 2.
 - B. The Sunbury ARC and the Northumberland County EMA agree to coordinate their emergency response activities in an interdependent manner.
 - C. For those disasters that require the activation of a Northumberland County Emergency Operations Center, the ARC will provide an experienced representative to represent the ARC at the County EOC upon request.
 - D. The ARC will coordinate the disaster relief efforts of other voluntary agencies with which it has written agreements for mutual cooperation in times of disaster.
 - E. The ARC will pre-plan the availability and staffing of facilities needed for mass care.
 - F. The ARC will select key staff members for each mass care center and train them in advance to function effectively on a 24 hour basis during emergencies. Those pre-selected should include: Center Managers and Assistants, Nursing Staff, Family Service Counselors, Food Service Personnel, Storekeepers and Maintenance Staff.
 - G. The ARC Chapter Sunbury is responsible for recruiting and training volunteers to fulfill its functions throughout the jurisdiction of the Chapter. The ARC should keep the County EMA informed regarding available training opportunities and, where training programs are similar, attempt to consolidate the training into a single program.
 - H. When the Northumberland County EMA decides it is necessary to open one or more mass care centers, the ARC is responsible for notifying the predesignated mass care center managers.
 - I. Since the ARC requires early notification in order to be able to respond adequately to disasters, the Sunbury Chapter will provide Northumberland County EMA with a list of key personnel and their phone numbers for alert/notification purposes.

J. The ARC will participate in obtaining written agreements with the County and owners/directors or School Boards of facilities to be used as mass care centers.


K. The ARC will report its unmet needs at the mass care centers to the Northumberland County EMA.

6. PLANNING AND IMPLEMENTATION

A. Cooperative arrangements for planning, exchange of information and continuing liaison regarding preparedness and disaster operations will be developed and maintained by the Northumberland County EMA and the Sunbury ARC Chapter.

B. All disaster planning will take into account the cooperative and mutually supporting nature of the two parties.

Amateur Radio

The Annex Maintenance and Concurrent page shows Northumberland County Communications Officer certifying that Amateur Radio will be available. Per discussions with county personnel, this statement is based on a verbal agreement and no formal documentation is available.

Emergency Alert System

The Pennsylvania State Emergency Alert System is the FCC-mandated document outlining the organization and implementation of the State of Pennsylvania's Emergency Alert System. The purpose of the document is to operationally define the system intended for the dissemination of emergency information and warnings to the general public within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania utilizing the resources of the Broadcast and Cable Industries. The existence of the EAS Plan supersedes the need for specific agreements and/or statements of understanding.

A copy of the Pennsylvania Emergency Alert System State EAS Plan is included as Attachment 13.

**STATEMENT OF AGREEMENT
CONCERNING THE USE OF FACILITIES AS A MASS CARE SHELTER
BY THE AMERICAN RED CROSS**

This agreement is made and entered into between the governing board of SHIKELLAMY SCHOOL DISTRICT of Northumberland County, state of Pennsylvania, and the Sunbury Area Chapter of the American National Red Cross.

Recitals


Pursuant to the terms of federal statutes, the Red Cross provides emergency services in behalf of individuals and families who are victims of disaster. SHIKELLAMY SCHOOL DISTRICT is authorized to permit the Red Cross shelters required in the conduct of Red Cross Disaster Services activities, and wishes to cooperate with the Red Cross for such purposes.

The parties hereto mutually desire to reach an understanding that will result in making the aforesaid facilities of SHIKELLAMY SCHOOL DISTRICT available to the Red Cross for the aforesaid use. Now, therefore, it is mutually agreed between the parties as follow:

1. SHIKELLAMY SCHOOL DISTRICT agrees that, after meeting its responsibilities to pupils/parishioners/members/clients, it will permit, to the extent of its ability and upon request by the Red Cross, the use of its physical facilities by the Red Cross as mass shelters for the victims of disaster.
2. The American Red Cross agrees that it shall exercise reasonable care in the conduct of its activities in such facilities and further agrees to replace or reimburse SHIKELLAMY SCHOOL DISTRICT for any foods or supplies that may be used by the Red Cross in the conduct of its relief activities in said mass shelters.

In witness thereof, the governing board of the SHIKELLAMY SCHOOL DISTRICT has caused this agreement to be executed by the Sunbury Area Chapter, said agreement to become effective and operative upon the fixing of the last signature hereto.
