Current Tenant / Use: Primary patient care facility at WRAMC from 1977 to present

Construction Information: Building 2 is the Main Hospital for the WRAMC Complex. The building consists of 8 levels 1st Floor to 7th Floor plus Basement. Each floor has an interstitial mechanical level above it for piping, wiring, A/C ducts, and other infrastructure.

Date of Construction: 1977

Construction: Steel frame with concrete walls and facings; concrete floors with tile and carpet, Drop and painted concrete ceilings

Building 2 has an active Nuclear Medicine clinic, Radiation Oncology and Radiology units, and several research laboratories that use radioactive materials. Rooms 7544 and 7545 are used by the HPO for temporary radioactive waste storage.
