Letter to Be Signed by Executive Director for Operations

On July 5, 2012, the Executive Director for Operations signed a letter to Ms. Sandra Blanco of CampCo. Ms. Blanco had requested that the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) amend its requirements in Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) 32.14, "Certain Items Containing Byproduct Material; Requirements for License to Apply or Initially Transfer," 10 CFR 32.15, "Same: Quality Assurance, Prohibition of Transfer, and Labeling," and 10 CFR 32.22(b) to include illumination markers containing tritium. The Executive Director for Operations informed Ms. Blanco that her request did not meet the acceptance criteria for a petition for rulemaking.

Ms. Blanco's request does not meet the NRC's acceptance criteria for a petition for rulemaking as outlined in 10 CFR Section 2.802, "Petition for Rulemaking," because it lacks: (1) supporting documentation and other pertinent information on relevant technical, scientific, or other data involved, which is reasonably available, and other pertinent information necessary to support the action the petitioner requested; (2) specific cases that the petitioner is aware of in which the current rule is deficient or needs to be strengthened; (3) dose calculations that the petitioner stated were an enclosure to her request; and (4) clarity on which regulations the petitioner wants amended.

Ms. Blanco has been advised that she must meet the criteria in 10 CFR 2.802 within 90 days from the date of the letter.
