### FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT REQUEST

To Whom It May Concern:

Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), U.S.C. 552, I, as a concerned citizen, hereby request from the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) information for the subject matter described as follows. This request covers, but is not limited to, all calendars and schedules, draft and final reports, correspondence, memoranda, handwritten notes, records of telephone contacts, receipts, electronic communications, including fax transmissions and E-mail, or otherwise written records, whether in paper or computer files, preserved via the use of any medium (e.g., paper documents, final notes, or word processors or computer discs, diskettes, hard drives, or network systems). In addition, this request includes studies, photographs (print and digital), analyses, work papers, internal or external communications of any sort, testimony, press releases, reports, data, memoranda or the like, concerning, recording, or in any way related to:

- 1) The leak in the safety injection/refueling water tank at the Palisades Nuclear Power Plant, Covert, Michigan, first discovered several weeks ago according to Entergy spokesperson Mark Savage in press release to The Kalamazoo Gazette reported on June 12, 2012.
- 2) All communications to and from U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), including its Region III Office, and Entergy that reference the leak in the safety injection/refueling water tank mentioned above;
- 3) All communications to and from NRC, including Region III Office, and Entergy having to do with the root cause analysis, the extent, and the corrective actions associated with the leak in the safety injection/refueling water tank;

Pursuant to this request, please provide all documents and communications prepared or utilized by, in the possession of, or routed through the NRC related to items 1-3 above from April 23, 2012 through the date of this request.

For any portion of this request that you deem appropriate to deny, I request that you describe the information that is denied, identify the exception to the FOIA on which you rely, and explain how that exception applies to the withheld information.

*I request that any searching and copying fees incurred as a result of this search be waived since the requested information is currently not publicly available through the agency's public document room. Please send pursuant requested documents electronically, if possible.*

*Please confirm receipt of this request, and advise when I can anticipate response to my request.*
