SUBJECT: Summary of Meeting to Review Draft Requests For Additional Information

On Friday, June 15, 2012, I met with Gerard Couture, Licensing Manager, from the Westinghouse Columbia Fuel Fabrication Facility (CFFF). On Monday, June 18, 2012, I called Mr. Couture to follow up on the same subject. The purpose of the meeting and call was to ensure that requests for additional information (RAIs) are understood by the licensee and to eliminate unnecessary RAIs.

The license application makes organizational changes at the CFFF and revises the license application by consolidating and updating information. For example, the S-1 condition of the License SNM-1107 has a reference to a letter for a safety commitment. In the license application, the commitment is explicitly stated. Another license condition is also stated in the application. The discussion explains the reason for the statements appearing in the revised license application, making the RAIs to understand why the statements were inserted into the license application unnecessary.

I informed the licensee that, where appropriate, responses can be made as page changes to the revised application.

The remaining RAIs were understood by the licensee.
