Our major concern is if workers locked-out, or as Entergy prefers on paid holiday, are part of the call-in contingent in event of an accident, will sufficient staffing occur in their absence? Next we want assurance that onsite NRC staff are sufficient in number to include oversight to assure that the two-man rule is rigidly followed.
