Based upon your documented inspection of the Victoria, Texas G4S Secure Solutions, USA (G4S) remote office on June 18, 2012, and your documented commitments for the day-to-day operating procedures in support of SGI safekeeping and storage requirements, the NRC staff has determined that G4S has met the regulatory requirements, as prescribed by Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* 73.21, for possession, handling and storage of SGI at its remote office located in Victoria, Texas.

Therefore, G4S may possess, handle and store SGI at its remote office located in Victoria, Texas. NRC approval for G4S possession and storage of SGI is limited to the aforementioned remote office location and the previously approved facilities located in Raeford, North Carolina and Omaha, Nebraska. Request for consideration of additional facilities must be forwarded to the NRC, and will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
