On 18 June 2012, Eric Wilson, Program Manager for the Composite Adversary Force inspected a G4S remote office located in Victoria, Texas. The inspection included an examination of (1) the security storage container; (2) computer and peripheral equipment; (3) destruction equipment; (4) policy review and compliance; and security related discussions with remote office personnel. As direct result of the physical examination and information obtained during the Victoria, Texas inspection we request that the above listed remote office be added to the existing approval letter dated April 16, 2012 referencing the remote G4S offices located in Raeford, North Carolina and Omaha, Nebraska.

Based on the inspection of the Victoria, Texas remote G4S office and documented commitments for the day to day operating procedures in support of SGI safekeeping and storage requirements, we feel that this location meets the regulatory requirements, as perscribed by Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations 73.21 fo possession, handling and storage of SGI.
