10 CFR 50 and 52, "Onsite Emergency Response Capabilities,"

This letter is being submitted in response to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) request for comments concerning the Advance Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (ANPR) 10 CFR 50 and 52, "Onsite Emergency Response Capabilities," published in the *Federal Register* on April 18, 2012 (i.e., 77FR23161).

The NRC issued this ANPR to begin the process of potentially amending its regulations to strengthen and integrate onsite emergency response capabilities. This regulatory action is one of the actions stemming from the NRC's lessons-learned efforts associated with the March 2011 Fukushima Dai-ichi accident in Japan. In support of this effort, the NRC is soliciting public comment on specific questions and issues regarding possible changes to onsite emergency response capabilities, and development of both new requirements and the supporting regulatory basis.

Exelon Generation Company, LLC (Exelon) appreciates the opportunity to comment on this ANPR. Exelon endorses and fully supports the comments submitted by the Nuclear Energy Institute (NEI) on behalf of the industry in its letter dated June 18, 2012.
