The purpose of this letter is to revise the schedule for the response to the request for additional information (RAI) identified in the NRC e-mail correspondence to UniStar Nuclear Energy, dated May 14, 2012 (Reference 1). This RAI addresses Seismic System Analysis, as discussed in Section 3.7.2 of the Final Safety Analysis Report (FSAR), as submitted in Part 2 of the Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant (CCNPP) Unit 3 Combined License Application (COLA), Revision 8.

Reference 2 indicated that a response to RAI 343 Questions 03.07.02-70 through -74 would be provided to the NRC by April 15, 2013. Subsequent discussions with NRC staff indicated that this response date did not adequately support the FSAR Chapter 3.7 review schedule. Therefore, the response to RAI 343 will be provided by January 31, 2013.


