We have been working strenuously to obtain the decommissioning bond. Amongst the things we have done recently was to organize a visit to the cyclotron for Carrion & Laffitte Insurance. They are the largest insurance brokers in PR. The visit turned out to be quite exciting for them. They have expressed plenty of confidence in being able to provide the bond. I also met recently with Mr Tony Ginorio, previously chief accountant and recently retired partner at Price, Waterhouse. Both companies helped me quite a lot when I started a Radiology Practice more than 30 years ago. Our in-house accountants have also worked to bring up to date our financials. All things considered, we should have all our objectives fully accomplished by early next week.

We have placed a downpayment to Positron, Inc for their automatic dispensing unit. I believe the biggest value such dispensing units provide is less risk of radiation exposure. This has been quite a concern since the first day I considered installing a cyclotron. Some years ago I visited, together with some friends from the University of Bonn, the Comcer factory in Italy, producing a similar dispensing unit but our experience at such an early date was not very positive.

I am also interested in producing AZD4694 which is F18 labeled radiopharmaceutical that has been quite successful in early diagnosis of cognitive disorders such as Alzheimer. Radiopharmacy becomes more interesting every day. We are committed to it and hopefully we will continue to provide state of the art developments.
