## General Comment

The waste classification tables in 10 CFR 61 should be revised to update the nuclide concentration values to be in harmony with the latest science from ICRP. This alignment will properly risk inform the regulation.

I think it would be wise to develop a second set of tables for a dry site versus a wet site. The latest Performance Assessment models will enable two sets of generic tables to be developed. I believe the waste Classification tables should be retained to aid waste generators in day to day packaging tasks during periods when a waste disposal site may not be available.

I support the addition of a frame work to enable site specific waste acceptance criteria to be developed for a disposal site to be added to the regulation.
