SUBJECT: TERMINATION OF NRC RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS LICENSE

Dear Dr. Peck:


In letter dated May 2, 2012, you contacted the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission and indicated that you wished to terminate NRC Materials License No. 21-04082-01 for Henry Ford Macomb Hospital – Warren Campus. In the aforementioned letter, you also included NRC Form 314, "Certificate of Disposition of Materials," and other supporting documentation of the decommissioning of the Warren Campus at 13355 East Ten Mile Road, Warren, Michigan. On June 14, 2012, Mr. Alan Jackson of your staff also provided some additional information regarding leak tests of sealed sources in an e-mail exchange with me. The NRC staff has reviewed all of this information, including your final status surveys. Based on its review, the staff has concluded that all licensable radioactive material has been removed from your facility and residual radioactive material attributable to licensed activities does not exceed current NRC criteria.

Based on these conclusions, no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material is required. Your facility at 13355 East Ten Mile Road, Warren, Michigan, is suitable for unrestricted use and NRC License No. 21-04082-01 is hereby terminated.
