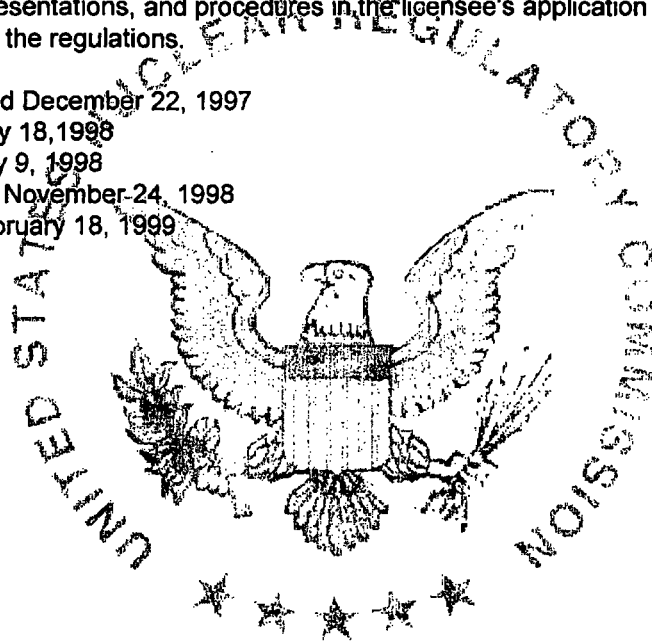

12. Licensed material shall be used by, or under the supervision and in the physical presence of individuals who have been designated in writing by the Radiation Safety Officer and have been trained:
- A. As specified in the application dated December 22, 1997, and the letters dated May 18, 1998 and July 9, 1998; and
  - B. In accordance with the provisions of 10 CFR 34.43.
13. The Radiation Safety Officer for this license is Richard J. Jastremski.
14. The licensee shall restrict the possession of licensed material to quantities below the minimum limit specified in 10 CFR 30.35(d), 40.36(b), and 40.26(c) for establishing financial assurance for decommissioning.
15. Source retrievals shall be performed by persons specifically licensed by the Commission or an Agreement State to perform such services.
16. A. Notwithstanding the periodic leak test required by 10 CFR 34.25(b), the requirement does not apply to radiography sources that are stored and not being used. The sources excepted from this test shall be tested for leakage before use or transfer to another person. No sealed source shall be stored for a period of more than 10 years without being tested for leakage and/or contamination.
- B. Sealed sources authorized for a use other than radiography shall be tested for leakage in accordance with 10 CFR 34.25.
17. Sealed sources containing licensed material shall not be opened or sources removed from source holders by the licensee.



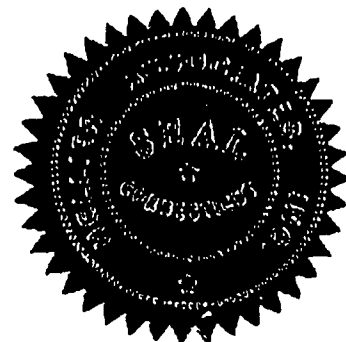
