By letter dated November 15, 2010, AREVA submitted for U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff review TR EMF-2103(P), Revision 2, "Realistic Large Break LOCA Methodology for Pressurized Water Reactors." To address PWR safety analysis concerns, AREVA submitted TR EMF-2103(P), Revision 2, Supplement 1, Revision 0, on December 20, 2011. As Supplement 1, supersedes the previous submittal, the NRC staff will issue one, consolidated safety evaluation for TR EMF-2013. It was agreed upon in a telephone conference between Gayle Elliott, AREVA Product Licensing Manager and the NRC staff on July 12, 2012, that TAC No. ME5356 would be closed. As such, staff hours to complete the review of TR EMF-2103(P), Revision 2, Supplement 1, Revision 0, will be charged to TAC No. ME7965.
