On March 12, 2012, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) issued Reference 1. Enclosure 3 of Reference 1 contains specific Requested Actions, Requested Information, and Required Responses associated with Recommendation 2.3: Seismic. This letter provides the Florida Power & Light Company (FPL) 120-day response to Reference 1 for Recommendation 2.3 for Seismic for the Turkey Point Nuclear Generating Station (Turkey Point) Units 3 and 4.

For seismic Recommendation 2.3 (walkdowns), Enclosure 3 of Reference 1 states that each licensee will confirm that they intend to use the NRC-endorsed seismic walkdown procedure or provide to the NRC a description of the process that will be used to conduct the walkdowns and to develop the needed information.

FPL confirms that it will use the seismic walkdown procedure (EPRI 1025286, "Seismic Walkdown Guidance: For Resolution of Fukushima Near-Term Task Force Recommendation 2.3: Seismic") that was endorsed by Reference 2 as the basis for conducting the walkdowns and developing the needed information at Turkey Point Units 3 and 4.

This letter does not contain any regulatory commitments.
