Supplemental Cultural Resource Reports

Detailed archaeological and architectural/historical surveys at and in the vicinity of the Bell Bend Nuclear Power Plant (BBNPP) site in Luzerne County, Pennsylvania have been conducted to support the licensing and permitting of the BBNPP project. This appendix provides copies of reports produced in association with cultural resource investigations completed to date, and correspondence with the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission (PHMC). All work has been completed in coordination with PHMC.

The cultural resource investigations completed for BBNPP between 2007 and 2010 being provided include a Phase Ia reconnaissance survey (Letter report and Technical report), three separate Phase Ib surveys, and a combined Phase I Cultural Resources Investigation and Phase II National Register Site evaluation. An additional Phase II evaluation of a single site will be completed in December 2011. PHMC has concluded that there are no architectural site impacts and thus no Criteria of Effects Analysis is needed. Final PHMC clearance is expected in mid-2012 and a final clearance letter will be filed for inclusion in the application record when received.
