To Whom It May Concern,

We are contacting the NRC today to request expedition of the Materials License amendment application we submitted 6/14/12. In that letter we provided information concerning our camera that was deemed un-repairable and was to be replaced at the new facility we were to open on 6/21/12. Our new camera has arrived this week and we have a back log as of today of 11 patients waiting for nuclear medicine studies. Barrett Hospital is a "frontier" critical access hospital located 70 miles from the nearest hospital with a nuclear medicine department that could accommodate our patients; this poses a serious medical hardship on our service areas future outpatients, current inpatients and the patients on our waiting list (some of who have been waiting since the end of May for services). With this letter we would like to make a formal request for an immediate review of our amendment due to a serious medical emergency state. If there is anyway this could be accomplished we would greatly appreciate the opportunity to serve our patients in their community. Thank you for your attention to this matter.

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
