
Reference 2 indicated that a response to RAI 343 Questions 03.07.02-70 through -74 would be provided to the NRC by April 15, 2013. Subsequent discussions with NRC staff indicated that this response date did not adequately support the FSAR Chapter 3.7 review schedule. Therefore, the response to RAI 343 will be provided by January 31, 2013.
