SUBJECT: AUDIT OF THE U.S. NUCLEAR REGULATORY COMMISSION'S
PROTECTION OF SAFEGUARDS INFORMATION (OIG-12-A-12)

In a memorandum to the Assistant Inspector General for Audits, dated May 9, 2012 (ML121220088), the Office of the Executive Director for Operations responded to the Office of Inspector General (OIG) memorandum dated April 16, 2012 (ML12108A069), on the subject OIG audit. In that memorandum, the recommendations made by the OIG were agreed to and target completion dates were identified for each of the recommendations.

The purpose of this memorandum is to inform you that the staff of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) has completed the task needed to sufficiently address recommendation #6 of the subject line referenced OIG Audit.

The Office of Nuclear Security and Incident Response (NSIR) staff have established an interim policy for granting non-NRC employees, contractors, and consultants access to Safeguards Information. That interim policy will be published as a Yellow Announcement (ML12164A342), found in the enclosure and will be effective immediately. The interim policy will be incorporated into Management Directive 12.7, "NRC Safeguards Information Security Program," when it is revised, by May 30, 2014.
