Reference 1 approved the Physical Security Plan submitted via Reference 2 by Westinghouse Electric Company LLC (Westinghouse) for the Hematite Decommissioning Project. Pursuant to 10 CFR 70.32(e), minor revisions have been made to the Physical Security Plan that would not decrease the effectiveness of the Physical Security Plan. Attachment 1 is the revised Physical Security Plan.


Attachment 2 is the revision matrix identifying the specific changes and the reasons for those changes. The changes are based on (a) clarifications to align internal inconsistencies and improvements to text that could potentially be misinterpreted, or (b) a need to relocate a small section of the security fence around a valve belonging to the public water district.
