NRC staff contacted the licensee to clarify the following information provided in an amendment request letter dated May 18, 2012:

1. A request was made to add Dr. Michael Malin as the Radiation Safety Officer (RSO). Supplemental information provided in the NRC Form 313A appeared to be incomplete. The current license lists material authorization for uses permitted under 10 CFR 35.100, 35.200, and 35.300, and Dr. Malin as an authorized user (AU) for all three uses. However, the NRC Form 313A requested for only 35.100 and 35.200 authorizations, and indicated training and preceptor attestation for 35.100 and 35.200 uses for Dr. Malin. Mr. Beaulieu explained that they only use Iodine-131 for uptake studies, and do not use or plan to use materials that fall under 35.300. He stated that he would discuss this with other management and provide a response by COB tomorrow, July 19, 2012.

On July 19, 2012, Mr. Beaulieu confirmed that they no longer need to have 35.300 on their license as they no longer perform any of these procedures, and would like to remove authorization for I-131 permitted by 10 CFR 35.300 and the corresponding user authorizations for Drs. Bushey, Gibney, Gumbardo, Lehman, Malin, Olcese, and Ajemian. On July 26, 2012, Ms. Murphy also confirmed that the activity range of I-131 uptake studies is 10 – 23 microcuries (μCi), with a max activity of 17 μCi. I discussed with Ms. Ouellette and Ms. Murphy and informed them that removal of 35.300 will include I-131 sodium iodide for imaging and localization studies as well. I also informed the licensee that they would need to request and receive and Amendment if they wish to restart this program.

2. The amendment request letter which was signed by the current RSO, Dr. Robert M. Lehman, listed his title as owner. A review of the docket files showed that previous correspondence was signed by office manager, Beth Ouellette. Mr. Beaulieu confirmed that Dr. Lehman is one of their many management representatives, and is one of the owners (12 equal part ownership) of the company.
