No report has been submitted since that time. As corrective actions, the licensee submitted the required report on July 26, 2012 to NRC Headquarters with a copy to the regional office. The report covered the period from the date of the most recent report to the end of the calendar year 2011. The licensee also added an annual notice in their Outlook calendar as a reminder to assure that future reports are filed prior to January 31 of each year, consistent with the requirements of 10 CFR 32.29(c).

This is a Severity Level IV violation.
