I tried to reach you again today by cell phone. I tried your cell phone and other numbers two weeks ago as well, and sent you an email on July 17, but have not yet heard back from you. Please let me know what progress you have made on obtaining financial assurance. The last update from you was an email dated July 2, in which you told me you were having a meeting with your Administrator and your accounting consultants, regarding obtaining a decommissioning bond from Carrion & Laffitte Insurance, the largest insurance brokers in PR.

In that email, you also indicated you were purchasing new equipment for the cyclotron facility. During an earlier telephone call, however, you said that you intend to operate the cyclotron again but will have to hire and train new employees as those who were working at the cyclotron have found other jobs since the cyclotron was closed down due to not having financial assurance. I would appreciate knowing of any changes in your intention to re-start the cyclotron.
