Dear Mr. Lambert:

This letter is in response to the Exit Briefing from the July 24, 2012 inspection of PETNET's Indianapolis Facility. For ease of reference, the item cited in your briefing is reproduced followed by PETNET's response.

- *Violation of License Application Section 6*
Contract couriers observed not frisking themselves or their carts when exiting the radioactive restricted area.

The Indianapolis facility will prohibit entry of the drivers and their carts into the radioactive restricted areas. PETNET will load delivery cases onto a cart and roll to the door of the restricted area. Contract courier drivers will transfer the cases from that cart to their carts without entering the restricted area.

To prevent future similar incidents, PETNET will train the contract courier drivers to enforce that access to the restricted area is not allowed. Furthermore the floor at the entrances to the restricted area will be marked with magenta/yellow hashed tape.

Be assured that PETNET is committed to maintaining compliance with all NRC and radioactive materials licensing requirements.
