Pierre,

As previously conveyed over the telephone, GEH is working on responses to the request for additional information regarding the use of the Model 2000 Type B Package (CoC 9228).

Effective July 17, 2012, GEH issued a management directive to suspend use of the Model 2000 package with the optional lead liner configuration. This administrative hold will remain in place until the NRC questions regarding the liner shipping configuration have been resolved. Hence, the previously identified Model 2000 Co-60 shipment, using the shielded lead liner, from the Hope Creek nuclear power plant to GEH's Vallecitos Nuclear Center (VNC) in August/September 2012 has been placed on hold.

Presently, GEH is aware of two additional shipments using the Model 2000 Package this calendar year. The Idaho National Laboratory intends to ship Co-60 using the Barrel Rack configuration to VNC. Shipment details have not been finalized, but the shipments are expected in August/September 2012 and October/November 2012.

Updates regarding the use of the Model 2000 Package will be communicated in separate transmittals, as information becomes available.
