# Plant Performance 2011

---

- **Operated Safely and Reliably in 2011**
  - Best industrial safety performance in station history
  - Reached more than 7 million safe work hours
  - Achieved 96.2% Capacity Factor, third best in station history
  - Safely completed Unit 2 refueling outage
  - Began dry cask storage campaign
  - Received Wildlife at Work certification and Achieved ISO 14001 Environmental recertification
  - Based on learnings from Fukushima completed extensive reviews of equipment, structures and procedures and purchases of additional backup emergency equipment

# Tritium Remediation

---

- **Remediation efforts are working - concentrations reduced by 90%**
  - The tritium plume continues to decrease in size and concentration as remediation efforts continue
  - All plume levels are well below the federal standard of 20,000 picocuries per liter pCi/l
  - We are committed to keeping the public informed

# Supporting the Community
