If you can get a sample with the existing pump for a baseline, great...but if the well is not in use and you cannot use the existing pump, no. You should not go to the expense to install a new pump for a well that is not being used. However, if the BLM or anyone does start using the well, you will need to sample the well to comply with the LC.

Tanya,

License condition 12.15 requires sampling of water supply wells within one (1) kilometer of the license area. The BLM has a well that falls within the 1 kilometer but the well is not in use and appears to have a pump in it that runs off of a solar panel system designed by the BLM. Do we need to make an effort to get approval from the BLM to remove the existing pumping system and install a new pumping system that is usable? I guess my concern is, to what level of effort do we need to go to sample a well beyond our control?
