8/12/2012 (11:00) Mr. Smith called on behalf of the licensee to discuss the deficiency letter that had been forwarded to him. He stated that he had reviewed the Federal Register referred to in the NRC's letter and the STA in NUREG-1757, Vol. 3, Rev. 1. Mr. Smith wanted to e-mail a copy of the STA when he had completed it for my review. I stated that it would be unnecessary for that step in the process if the wording in the NUREG was used and he should work together with the bank that would serve as the trustee on that issue. Mr. Smith asked whether the September 1<sup>st</sup> deadline mentioned in the letter was a firm date or not. I replied that it was not a firm date but recommended to give me time to review the document along with a number of other institution's documents and get a response out if more information or changes were necessary. I stated that I would get back in touch with him about September 15<sup>th</sup> if an STA had not been submitted to the NRC for review at that time.
