Dear NRC licensee:

The purpose of this communication is to inform you about an upcoming public meeting on September 10, 2012, regarding a potential 2.206 petition submitted by Thomas Saporito.

On July 30, 2012, a 10 CFR 2.206 petition (ADAMS Accession No. ML12215A022) was submitted requesting that the NRC take enforcement-related action against all NRC licensees as a result of information provided on a Bloomberg News Agency broadcast which described a cybersecurity incident at Diablo Canyon. Mr. Saporito, the petitioner, has requested an opportunity to address the NRC's Petition Review Board in person before it meets internally to make its initial recommendation.

Management Directive 8.11, "Review Process for 10 CFR 2.206 Petitions", states that "the petition manager also will invite the licensee to participate in the meeting or teleconference to ensure that it understands the concerns about its facility or activities..." This e-mail serves to inform you about the upcoming public meeting in which Mr. Saporito will be offering additional information about his petition.
