*Courtesy Notice:* Cameco confirmed Well JM-007 was on excursion on August 8, 2012. Well JM-007 was then scheduled to be sampled every seven days for Chloride, Alkalinity, Conductivity, and Uranium until the excursion is mitigated. The well has been below excursion limits for the UCLs for three (3) consecutive weeks. As of August 29, 2012, this excursion is considered mitigated and no longer on an excursion status. Well JM-007 will resume its normal two week sampling frequency. Data and information on Well JM-007 will be provided in the August Excursion Update.
