PROGRAM SCOPE

This licensee was a private practice out-patient diagnostic clinic authorized to use material permitted by Sections 35.100, 35.200, and 35.300; the licensee only performed cardiac studies at the time of this inspection. Radioiodine had not been used since the previous inspection. The licensee operated two clinics in the suburban Detroit area; the Livonia office was expected to initiate activities within a few months. The licensee employed one part-time technologist at its Southfield location. The clinic administered approximately 3-4 diagnostic cardiology procedures every Tuesday. The licensee received unit doses from a licensed radiopharmacy. The licensee retained the services of a consulting physicist who audited the radiation safety program on a quarterly basis (last September 4, 2012, with no violations or unusual findings).

This inspection consisted of interviews with licensee personnel, a review of selected records, a tour of the nuclear medicine department, and independent measurements. At the time of this inspection, the licensee was in the process of obtaining new imaging equipment and no studies were conducted. This inspection included in-office review through September 5, 2012, to review a sampling of the consultant's program audit reports which could not be located during the on-site inspection.

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LICENSEE:

The inspection was an examination of the activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) rules and regulations and the conditions of your license. The inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector. The inspection findings are as follows:
