Discussed amendment request to use sources at temporary job sites to train LLEA and other first responders.
Requested the following issues be addressed:

- i. If the LLEA will be responsible for using/storing sources at temporary job sites, then confirm that the NIH RSC will approve an LLEA member as an authorized user responsible for oversight of these sources.
- ii. Confirm that the NIH RSC will approve written operating and emergency procedures for this use. The topics in Appendix H of NUREG-1556, Volume 1 may be helpful in developing these procedures.
- iii. Indicate whether only "sealed sources" will be used or whether other sources designed to prevent leakage will also be used.
- iv. Provide an upper range of activity (e.g., 10 mCi) or dose rate that will be implemented for sources used at temporary job sites.

Ms. Ribauda indicated that she would review these issues and a draft a reply for the RSO's signature.
