On March 12, 2012, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) issued Reference 1 to all power reactor licensees. Enclosure 3 of Reference 1 contains specific requested actions, requested information, and required responses associated with Recommendation 2.3 for seismic walkdowns. Nebraska Public Power District (NPPD) confirmed in Reference 2 that it would use the seismic walkdown procedure (Electric Power Research Institute Report 1025286, "Seismic Walkdown Guidance: For Resolution of Fukushima Near-Term Task Force Recommendation 2.3: Seismic") as endorsed by the NRC as the basis to conduct the walkdowns and develop the needed information at Cooper Nuclear Station (CNS).

Pursuant to Required Response 2 of Reference 1, Enclosure 3, NPPD is providing the Seismic Walkdown Report for CNS in the Enclosure.


