Mr. Larimore,

We have completed our review of the renewal submission for Cardiology Associates of Norwich, LLC [License No. 06-30793-01; Docket No. 03036181] and find that additional information is required. Specifically, please provide us with a current copy of the corporate structure for Cardiology Assoc. of Norwich. Our files indicate the initial application was signed by Marshall Katz, MD as were all correspondence until Nov. 15, 2007 [that letter was signed by Frederic West, Administrator]. A subsequent amendment request dated Sept. 25, 2008 removed Dr. Katz as the Radiation Safety Officer as well as an authorized user and listed Dr. Ting Li, MD, Ph.D. as RSO. Please include a statement indicating that management has reviewed the application and concurs in the statements and representations contained therein. Note also that a management representative should sign all future correspondence that requests a change in the license.

In addition, licensees are not required to provide their specific procedures as part of their renewal package; these items will be reviewed during inspection. Therefore our review did not include a review of the procedures for calibrating the dose calibrator or any other procedures you provided in the renewal application. Secondly, the floor plan included in the application should have been marked as "Security Related Information – Withhold Under 10 CFR 2.390." You may refer to RIS 2005-31 for guidance for marking documents.
