Dear Judges Gleason and Kline:

By letter of November 4, 1993, Maurice Axelrad, counsel for Sequoyah Fuels Corporation and General Atomics, sent you copies of his clients' requests for a hearing on the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's October 15, 1993, order requiring SFC and GA to provide guaranteed decommissioning funding for the SFC facility.

The purpose of this letter is to inform you that today, NACE requested leave to intervene in the hearing on the October 15 order. If our request is granted, however, we would not consider our participation that proceeding to constitute an adequate substitute for the license renewal hearing to which we continue to believe we are entitled. Our participation in the proceeding regarding the October 15 order would be at the discretion of the NRC, and would be limited to supporting the order, not challenging its sufficiency. Thus, NACE continues to press, in all respects, its opposition to SFC's motion to withdraw its license renewal application.
