Here are Virginia's comments:

1. In section IV, sub-sections C and F are identical. Virginia recommends deleting one of these sub-sections.
2. In sub-section V.B it states that if the Subject Matter Expert is unavailable then the Branch Chief, ASPB will provide the answer to the Subject Matter Expert who will then share it with the RSAO. Virginia does not understand why the Branch Chief would provide a technical subject response to the expert for forwarding to the RSAO. Virginia recommends that this be changed to allow the Branch Chief, ASPB to find another Subject Matter Expert to be assigned to the Agreement State question for response.
3. Virginia recommends that a new sub-section be added to section V regarding the monthly NRC/OAS conference call (SA-1101) and how this item should be used to provide information to the Agreement States.
