I live fifteen miles from Vermont Yankee Nuclear Power Plant, and I have recently made aware of an upcoming vote by the five NRC commissioners as to whether to recommend filtered vents for radiation at Mark I and Mark II nuclear power plants or to save money. It is ridiculous that these plants even exist to begin with: Vermont Yankee, for example, has a horrendous safety record and a record of manipulating the state government and other agencies that are trying to keep it safe.
