Question from Environmental Projects Branch 1 (EPB1)

NRC RAI Number: EIS 9.3.1-1 (eRAI 6353)

Please clarify whether or not the Augmented Site Selection Report supersedes the screening analyses in the ER. If only portions of the analyses in the ER are superseded, explain which portions are superseded and which are not.

Background. (FPL Response to NRC RAI No. 9.3.1-14; RAI 5588, L-2011-378 Dated 9/13/11: Response to NRC Environmental RAI Letter 1104071, Attachment 2). This response says "The regional screening process mentioned in the ER is superseded by a regional screening/candidate area identification process documented in the Augmentation Report (Reference 1)." However, the Augmented Site Selection Study Report (AA) dated August 2011, page 3 states "The AA does not supersede or replace analyses in the original Siting Report."

FPL RESPONSE:

Analyses presented in the Augmentation Report (Reference 1) are consistent in their entirety with material submitted in Section 9.3 of Revision 3 of the Turkey Point Units 6 & 7 Environmental Report (Reference 2). Revision 3 of ER Section 9.3 (submitted as part of Reference 2) supersedes in its entirety all previous revisions of Section 9.3. The Augmentation Report supplements the 2006 Siting Report for purposes of satisfying NRC guidance on consideration of alternate sites, but does not replace the 2006 report as documentation of decision processes executed at that time.

The Augmentation Report and ER Section 9.3, Rev 3., provide the complete basis for satisfying applicable NRC and National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) analysis of alternative sites for the Turkey Point Units 6 & 7 COL application.

As noted in its response to NRC RAI No. EIS 9.3.1-2; eRAI 5588 (Reference 1), FPL completed the Augmentation Report and conforming sections of ER 9.3, in part to "Address FPL's additional understanding of NRC guidance (NUREG-1555, Section 9.3) for the consideration of alternative sites subsequent to publication of the original 2006 Siting Report." FPL notes that these responses reflect the site selection decision *as it was conducted in 2006, when actual decisions were being made about the siting of a new nuclear power plant*, as is required under NEPA. FPL's Augmentation Report and ER Section 9.3, Rev. 3 do not address a re-consideration of the siting decision in terms of conditions existing in 2011, as this perspective is neither reflective of the real conditions surrounding plant site selection decisions and actions, nor is it consistent with the substance or intent of early planning under NEPA (40 CFR 1501.2).

This response is PLANT SPECIFIC.
