Mr. Smith,

By letter dated January 8, 2013 (ADAMS Accession No. ML13029A103), Honeywell International Inc. (Honeywell) submitted its decommissioning cost estimate for its Metropolis Works (MTW) facility as required by 10 CFR 40.36, "Financial Assurance and Recordkeeping for Decommissioning." Pursuant to 10 CFR 40.36(d) and its License Condition 25, Honeywell is required to submit its decommissioning funding plan and financial assurance every three years for NRC review and approval.

As part of the screening process, the NRC staff has completed the review of the information that Honeywell submitted on January 8, 2013, and found the information acceptable for detailed review. During this review, we will notify you if any additional information, or clarification of existing information, is needed. The staff efforts associated with this review will be charged to Technical Assignment Control (TAC) Number L36006. Please reference this TAC number in all correspondence related to this action.

Based on our preliminary review and projection of current review schedules, we anticipate completing our review of your request by July 2013. This date could change depending on the findings of our technical/administrative review, urgent assignments, or other factors. We will promptly communicate any significant changes to this schedule.
