Following processing at the Eastern Technologies, Inc. (ETI) facility, the secondary waste will be either returned directly to Laguna Verde, or shipped to a licensed third party waste processor for further volume reduction processing and returned to ETI for export back to Laguna Verde.</p> <p>This license is amended to: 1) remove references to Impact Services as the U.S. third party waste processing company; and 2) extend the expiration date from December 31, 2012 to December 31, 2015.</p>
