

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



It seems that some people actually missed getting the Q&As since I'm starting to get emails asking if I can do an update. Sorry it's been a while, for some reason my workload seems to have exploded...LOL. *(Actually I really have no excuse as Shelby has been a compiling machine!)*. We've added several new sections including **ACRONYMS**, located near the back. *(Thanks to Stephanie Devlin for pulling the acronyms together)*

Now that the agency is moving out of the heart of the emergency response phase, and looking towards short, medium and long term actions and goals, our little seismic group has been discussing what to do with this document; and specifically how to make it useful beyond this event. We've discussed the fact that ever since the Kashiwazaki earthquake, we have recognized the need to develop a "generic" seismic Q&A document so that the agency can hit the ground running in cases such as this. It

is obvious to us that we now have the guts of the document we've envisaged for years in one 140 page compilation; and it's time to make it happen!

**So the next time you see this document (which won't be for a while), it will be radically transformed.** We'll be putting all the "static" information in the front, and will be pulling the japan earthquake-specific information into a separate section. It will be more user friendly and will be easier to find any new information. It's unclear to us how long these updates will be useful, but we suspect, not much longer. So, now's the time to start wrapping it up and putting a bow on it...

We hope the new document will be worth the wait...



A high priority question we are working on is "how many plants are near a mapped active fault". We're focusing on anything within 50 miles. We're also pulling relevant questions from the congressional inquiries we just received; and will also give these high priority to support any needs by NRR.

Many new figures and some draft fact sheets have added to the "additional information" section. These include the NRO half of a tsunami fact sheet...a description of the tsunami research is still to come from RES.

Some good news: Yesterday's version seems to have been widely forwarded around the agency. So, we are also starting to get some excellent questions from staff looking forward. This is allowing us to feel that we are finally getting out in front of things to a small degree. Also, our team has grown and we now have someone acting as source of seismic expertise for the 11pm to

7 am shift. This means that we now have seismic experts available to the RST and OPA at the Op Center 24 hours, with 2 people during the day. That extra support is allowing us to get this out at least an hour earlier today ☺

**In the odds and ends department, in case you were wondering: according to our Historian....**

James Asselstine is the youngest Commissioner. He was just shy of 34 when he was appointed in 1982.

Chairman Jaczko was the second youngest to be appointed Commissioner. He was 34 years plus a few months. Nevertheless, he is the youngest –being appointed Chairman at 38.5 years of age.

**Here's the verbiage HQ has used to reply to questions on the Chairman's testimony (3/31) today:**

The six plants were as of the end of the assessment year (March-Feb.), we're actually down to three at this point.

The six the Chairman referred to are Fort Calhoun (Neb.), Robinson Unit 2 (S.C.), Wolf Creek (Kansas) and the three units at Oconee (S.C.). Oconee has subsequently improved and is back to our normal level of oversight.

Every plant receives at least the normal level of inspection and oversight, called "Licensee Response." If enough items of low significance appear, a plant will move to the second level of inspection, called "Regulatory Response." Items that aren't resolved in a reasonable amount of time, or new items of somewhat higher significance, can move a plant to the third level of even more inspection and oversight, "Degraded Cornerstone," and that's where the six plants were (and three still are). Serious issues, or significant issues that last even longer, move a plant to the fourth level, "Multiple (or Repetitive) Degraded Cornerstone," where there's intensive inspection and attention from senior NRC management. The last level is "Unacceptable Performance," where we shut a plant down until we determine it's safe to reopen.

### **Short version,**

The NRC felt the six (now three) required significant additional oversight but continue to operate safely.

### **SOARCA, our statement per Jennifer Uhle is:**

NRC is continuing its efforts on the State of the Art Reactor Consequence Analysis (SOARCA) project at a reduced pace since many of the staff and contractors working on SOARCA are assisting NRC's efforts regarding the Fukushima event. This will undoubtedly stretch the schedule out somewhat but we have not yet determined for exactly how long.

### **Georgia PIRG Report Summary**

The Georgia PIRG Report Summary is a compendium of already reported, widely known issues with which the NRC is quite familiar. In the 1980s and 1990s the NRC instituted substantial safety improvements at U.S. reactors, and after 9-11 the agency ordered many more into place to help deal with

As we have stated, the NRC will be looking at the data coming from Japan to take a fresh look at the regulatory regime in this country to determine if additional requirements are necessary to strengthen our approach to ensuring that reactor operators keep the public safe.

I've done that with mutually satisfactory results on health care reform issues, mostly because key officials recognize that I'm not looking for breaking news or direct quotes but rather for guidance on how to interpret information that is publicly available.
