ORDER
(Scheduling Teleconference)

The Board held a teleconference with the parties on February 26, 2013 to “refine the issues to be addressed at the hearing and to discuss any other matters bearing upon the hearing that might require consideration.”¹ During the teleconference, Ms. Smith explained that she was actively seeking counsel to represent her in this matter. The Board, with the agreement of NRC Staff counsel, gave Ms. Smith two weeks from the date of the teleconference to secure counsel.² On March 7, Ms. Smith informed the Board that she was unable to obtain counsel.

The Board has accordingly decided to reschedule the teleconference to discuss procedural matters related to the hearing. The teleconference will take place on Monday, March 18, at 10 am. Prior to the teleconference, the parties will be provided with the telephone number and pass code.

The parties should be prepared to discuss the following:

1. The schedule for the submission of initial written statements of position, written initial and rebuttal testimony with supporting affidavits, and other materials referred to in 10 C.F.R. § 2.1207.
2. The date and location of the evidentiary hearing.
3. Whether employees of Southern Nuclear Operating Co., Inc. (other than Ms. Smith) will be available to provide written testimony and/or testify at the hearing.
4. Whether subpoenas, pursuant to 10 C.F.R. § 2.319(b), will be necessary to assure the presence or testimony of any witness.
5. The procedure for the marking of testimony, affidavits and exhibits, the submission of exhibits to the Board, and the introduction of exhibits in evidence at the hearing.
6. Whether a protective order will be necessary to preserve the confidentiality of any exhibit and/or testimony.
7. Any other procedural matter of concern to a party that is related to the conduct of the evidentiary hearing.
