**Subject:** Acceptance Letter for SHINE Medical Technologies, Inc. Regarding Request for Exemption from the Requirements of 10 CFR 2.101(a)

By letter dated February 18, 2013, SHINE Medical Technologies, Inc. (SHINE) submitted an exemption request for an exemption from certain requirements of Paragraph 2.101(a) of Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations*. If granted, this exemption would allow SHINE to submit its construction application permit in two parts. The purpose of this e-mail is to provide the results of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff's acceptance review of this exemption request. The acceptance review was performed to determine if there is sufficient information in scope and depth to allow the NRC staff to complete its detailed review. The acceptance review is also intended to identify whether the application has any readily apparent information insufficiencies in its characterization of the regulatory requirements.

The NRC staff has reviewed your application and concluded that it does provide information in sufficient detail to enable the NRC staff to complete its detailed review and make an independent assessment regarding the acceptability of the proposed exemption in terms of regulatory requirements and the protection of public health and safety and the environment. Given the lesser scope and depth of the acceptance review as compared to the detailed technical review, there may be instances in which issues that impact the NRC staff's ability to complete the detailed review are identified despite completion of an adequate acceptance review.
